


6. OBJECTS OF THE TRUST:

The properties of the Trust shall be.-



9. QUALIFICATION

a) One Chairperson;



13. ROLE, FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF CHAIRPERSON:

He shall be responsible for communication with all the members and shall also keep records of the meetings and take proper and regular record of all the proceedings of the meetings of the Trustees held from time to time and other meetings including committee meetings.

15. ROLE, FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE TREASURER:

The Treasurer shall be the custodian of the entire Cash and Bank balances including Cheque Books, Bell Deposit Slips etc. and shall keep a complete record of all fund inflows and outflows of the Trust.

The Board of Trustees shall have the control and management of the Trust and exercise the following powers:

- a) To determine from time to time to commence and to take up the objects and purposes for which the funds of the trust shall be used and allot and allocate to each of the objects such portion of the funds as they deem fit;
- b) To purchase and acquire any immovable property of any kind for the object of the Trust or as a source of income for the Trust;
- c) To sell, lease, mortgage or dispose of any property, immovable property/properties belonging to the Trust.
- To incur all expenditure necessary as in their own opinion useful for carrying out the objects and administration of the trust;
- To open one or more bank accounts of the trust with any bank or banks as the Trustees may deem fit and deposit monies of the Trust in the Bank accounts.
- [f] To borrow for and on behalf of the Trust for the purpose of the object of the trust with or without security from banks, Financial Institutions, Governments, Universities or any other government Body/bodies both Central and State;
- to employ staffs of all levels necessary and useful for carrying out the objects of the trust.
- To institute, conduct, defend, compound, withdraw, compromise, adjust, refer to arbitration or to do such things as are incidental and necessary, concerning the affairs of the Trust and to sign and verify vakalatnamas, pleadings, affidavits and other powers

To delegate all or any of the powers vested in the Trustees to anybody to frame rules, bye laws and other codes of ethics for the conduct of the affairs of the Trust and its transactions and establishing any Committee;

j) To accept contributions in cash or in kind either by way of addition to the trust funds generally or for any one or more of the specified objects of the Trust.

- To carry out all or any other legal objects which may be necessary and expedient to carry out the objects of the Trust in a healthy and convenient manner.

17. Meetings of the Trustees:

- a) The Board of trustees shall meet at least once in six months or as often as in necessary with minimum 5 days notice or with a shorter notice with prior consent of all the trustees.
- An Annual Meeting shall be held within six months of close of every Financial Year to adopt the Audited Financial Statements of the Trust for the said Financial Year.
- ¹⁸c) The Chairperson shall preside over all the meetings of the trustees;
- d) The meetings of the Trustees may be convened by the Chairperson or under his direction by any other Trustees
- e) The quorum of the meeting of the Trustees shall be all the members personally present
- f) In the event of equality of votes, the person presiding such meeting shall exercise casting vote (additional vote).

18. RESOLUTIONS:

21. ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT:

- The Trustees shall maintain true and correct accounts of all Trust monies and of all the income and investments and all the outgoing expenses.
- b) The year of account shall be the financial year commencing from 1st APRIL and ending 31st March.
- c) The Trustees shall each year issue a report setting out the accounts showing the income and expenditure of the Trust for the preceding year not later than six months from the end of the preceding year of accounts.

d) The accounts of the Trust shall be audited every year by a Chartered Accountant who may be appointed for the purpose by the Board of Trustees and the audited statement of accounts together with Auditors' report shall be laid before the Annual Meeting of the Board of Trustees for approval.

£22. BANK ACCOUNT:

The Chairperson, Secretary, Treasurer and/or any other person so authorised shall operate the bank account(s) of the Trust as per the decision of the trust from time to time and responsible for all Bank transactions.

23. POWER TO ALTER RULES AND REGULATIONS:

The Board of Trustees shall have full power and authority to make, alter and rescind rules and regulations for the management and administration of the Trust. Any amendment to the Trust Deed will be duly intimated to the jurisdictional Chief Commissioner of Income Tax.

24. APPLICATION OF INCOME AND TRUST FUND:

The Board of Trustees shall be empowered to invest the funds of the Trust in movable or immovable properties, in such manner as they deem fit for the purpose of the objects of the trust provided that such investments shall be in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as well as of any other law for the time being in force as are applicable to charitable trusts.

25. REMUNERATION TO THE TRUSTEES:

The Trustees are not entitled for any remuneration. But they shall however be entitled to receive out of pocket expenses including reimbursement of all travelling expenses incurred by them in the course of discharging the functions of the Trust. Further the Income and funds of the Trust will be solely utilized towards the objects and no portion of it will be utilized for payment of Trustees by way profits, interest, dividend or otherwise.

26. INDEMNITY:

Every Trustee shall be indemnified out of the fund in respect of any loss arising from or contingent upon any investment made out of the monies of the Trust unless such loss shall have been occasioned by own negligence and also every Trustee shall be indemnified out of the Trust against all proceedings, suits, claims, costs, damages and expenses occasioned by any claim in connection with the matters or affairs relating to the Trust created by these presents or in the exercise of powers or discretion vested in them by virtue of these presents.

27. IRREVOCABILITY:

It is hereby expressly declared that the trust hereby created shall be irrevocable and for charitable purpose.

28. ACTIVITIES OF THE TRUST:

The activities of the Trust shall be only within India and its Union territories and shall not be extended anywhere outside India except as may be mutually decided by the members of the Trust and as may be permitted by law for the time being prevailing in India and outside.

29. DISSOLUTION:

On dissolution of the Trust, the net assets of the Trust shall be transferred to an association of persons or trust or society having similar objects of this Trust.

30. PROCEEDING OF THE TRUST:

Any defect in the constitution of the Trust shall not invalidate its proceedings.

§31. ENGAGEMENT OF THIRD PARTY:

The Board of Trustee may appoint such assistance or may engage contractors or casual labourers as they deem necessary from time to time to help them in the conduct of the affairs of
